On Site Property Managers Report

**Annual Dam Inspection
Lake Yanu**

Since 2005 the D.N.R. has given us very favorable reports on our annual dam inspections, we take great pride in making sure that all state requirements are met for a Class I Dam. This year our 2010 annual inspection supposedly went well, except the report for Lake Yanu that reported in the official report "That there was significant erosion on the sides of the channel downstream of the principal spillway. This needs to be investigated by an Engineer of Record (EOR) An EOR needs to be retained and our office notified in writing by July 2, 2010 to develop plans for rehabilitating the eroded channel at Yanu Lake Dam. Plans should be submitted to our office by October 2, 2010.

See Picture showing channel in question, I inspected the channel and found no erosion, I called the D.N.R Inspector that did the inspection to ascertain what he was talking about and was told "It was self evident and that I needed to follow the instructions in the report regarding an EOR and submit a letter and plans for rehabilitating the problem of erosion.

I called our Engineer of Record Greg Huddock with Golder & Associates; this is the company of Engineers that did the plans, now under review for the Lake Dakwa siphon system. I explained the situation with the D.N.R. Dam Inspection and that I had sent a letter as requested as to whom our EOR would be as it had to be in their office by July 2nd

Greg agreed to come to Walnut Mountain and assess the reported erosion; he took pictures and agreed with us that there is no erosion evident as stated in the D.N.R. report.

6/29 Gregg Huddock called me and said he had spoken with Tom Woosley Principal Engineer for the D.N.R. and faxed him pictures of the channel in question, Greg will send an official engineers letter to the D.N.R. along with the pictures. Tom Woosley agreed he could see no erosion and that upon receiving the official engineers report we W.M.P.O.A should here no more on the matter in question.
